

### Association of Manitoba Municipalities Conference 30-Second Active Transportation Survey Results

Municipal-level political and administrative represtatives, in Winnipeg to attend the Association of Manitoba Municipalities' 2010 annual convention, were asked to respond to a series of five questions regarding Active Transportation.


In total, 57 officials (councillors, mayors, chief administrative officers, reeves, etc..) were interviewed, representing municipalities from across the Province.

Represents Municipality in which one or more persons were surveyed.




# Question 1. Do you cycle or walk to run an errand in your community? (Daily, Weekly, Monthly, Yearly, Never)

Never	12%	




#### Question 2. Did you walk or bike to school when you were a kid? (y/n)

My community can make cycling and walking to school safer for kids.



My community is safely connected to major destinations by biking and walking


